One of the most hardy and attractive native trees around. It features dark green leaves and small, bluish-black fruit eaten by many species of birds.



Mature Size: 40'-60' and spread of 40'-60'

Light: partial shade - full sun

Soil Preference: medium to wet soils

Fall Foliage: fall colors of yellow, orange, bright red, purple or scarlet
