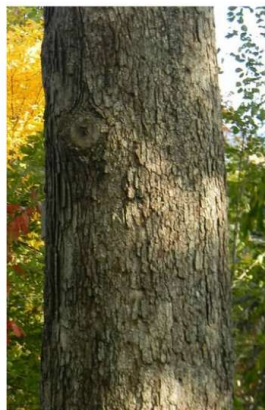


White Oak

Quercus alba

This slow-growing native is long-lived, provides food and habitat for wildlife, and makes a large stunning shade tree



Mature Size: 80'-100' and spread of 50'-80'

Light: partial shade - full sun

Soil Preference: well-drained to dry soils

Fall Foliage: dark red

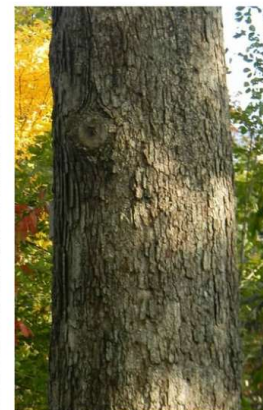


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
